



A 10-Day Pilgrim Tour to THE HOLY LAND

"Path of Prophecy and Passion – From John's Birthplace to the Mount of Olives"


- Breakfast at the Hotel

- Walk the Palm Sunday Road
 - Retrace Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem, amidst olive trees and sacred stones.
- 😢 Dominus Flevit
 - The site where "Jesus wept" over the future fate of Jerusalem. The teardropshaped chapel offers an unforgettable view of the Old City.
- Garden of Gethsemane & Church of All Nations (Church of Agony)
 - Kneel where Jesus prayed and agonized before His arrest.
 - A deeply moving experience amidst 2,000-year-old olive trees.
- A Mount Zion Visits
 - Room of the Last Supper The sacred site of the Eucharist's institution.
 - King David's Tomb Honoring Israel's beloved shepherd king.
 - Dormition Abbey Believed to be the site of the Blessed Virgin Mary's "eternal sleep."
- Dinner & Overnight in Bethlehem

OLD CITY OF JERUSALEM – JERICHO – DEAD SEA – BETHANY


